

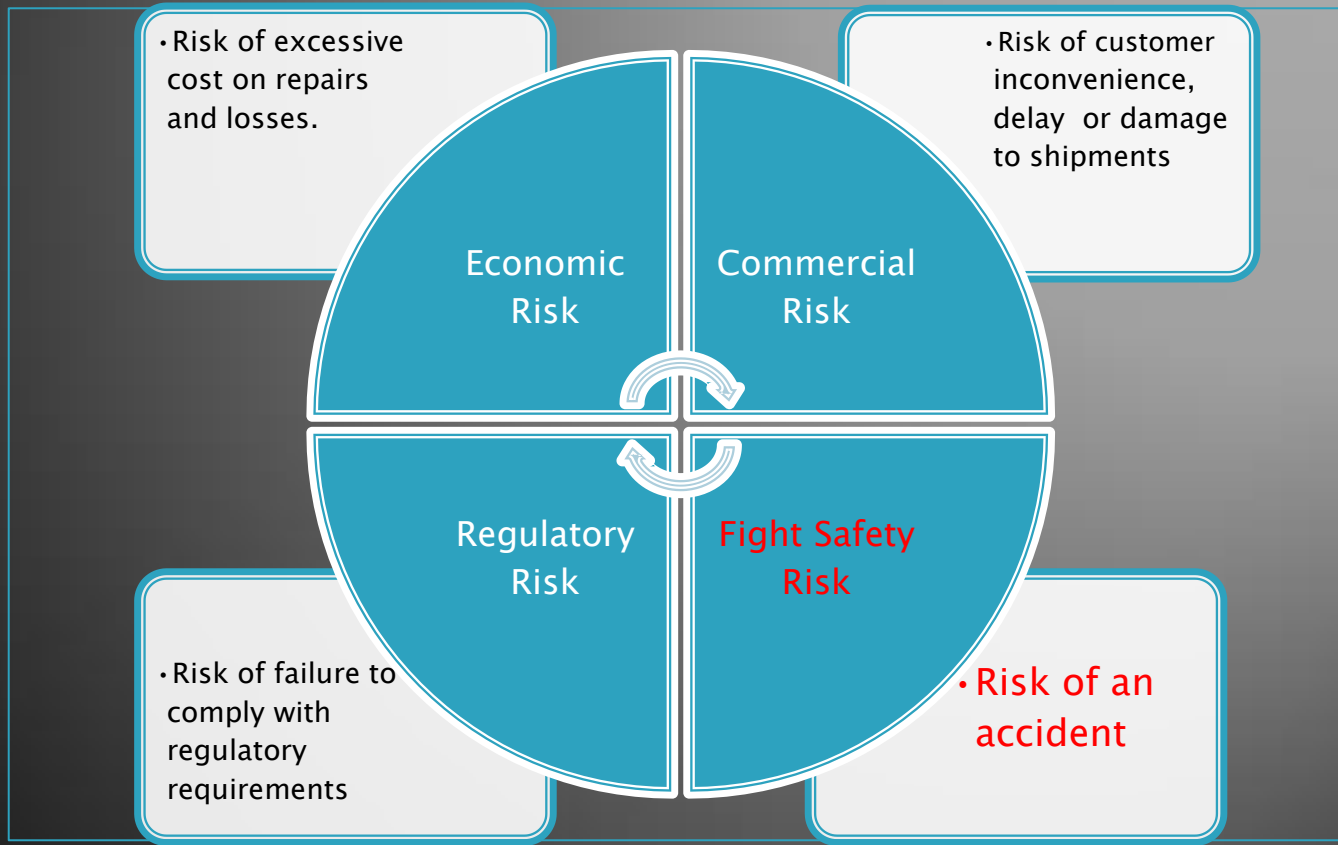

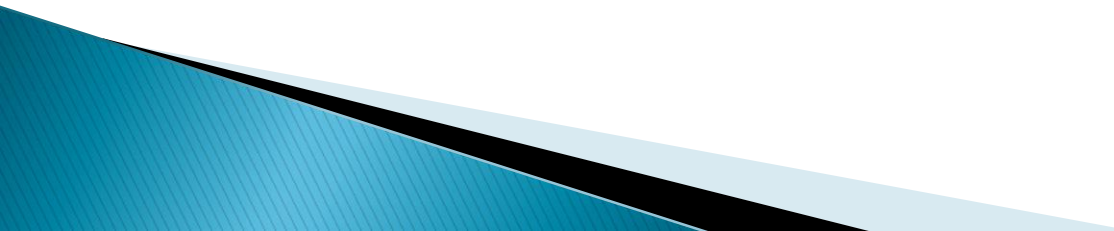


# What's the secret to our success?

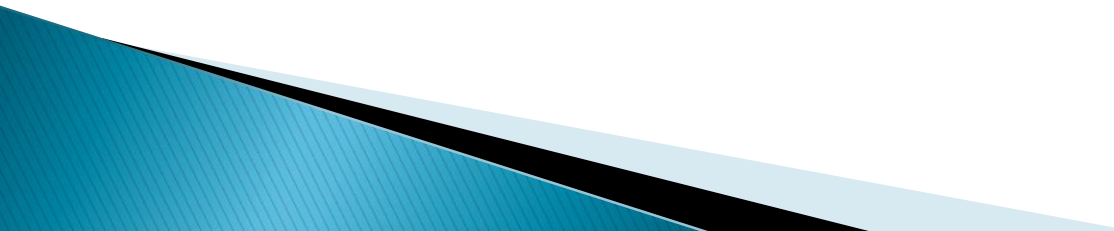

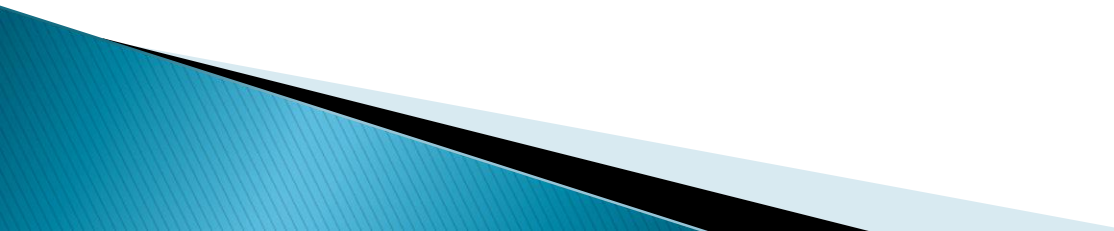
# Are we on track?

# Maintain momentum

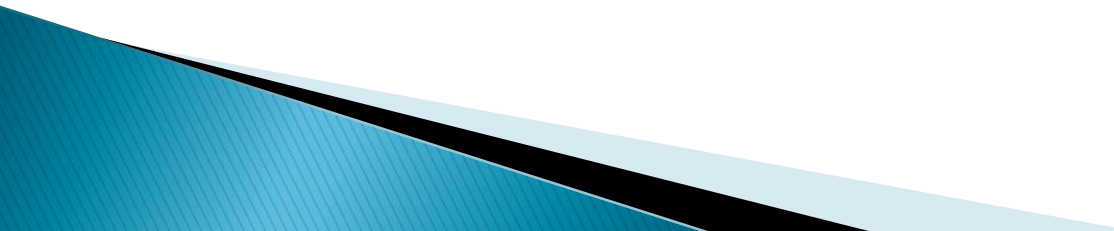
- ▶ More material on web site

  - ▶ Further collaboration with the Ground Handling, Airport and freight forwarder community
