Definition

A common code of conduct is written for employees of a company, which protects the business and informs the employees of the company's expectations. It is ideal for even the smallest of companies to form a document containing important information on expectations for employees. The document does not need to be complex or have elaborate policies, but the file needs a simple basis of what the company expects from each employee.





Deliverables

- That a basic level of conduct be widely promoted wherever ULD are to be found, with the ambition that the PEOPLE who handle the ULD observe the ULD CARE ULD Code of Conduct.
- That an understanding of the very most basic principles of ULD be widely understood





How does it work?

 - Partly "hard copy"
 - Mainly on line material- easily accessed
- ULD CARE supports the C of C through ULD Explained, ULD Instruct and ULD Connect

ULD CARE Code of Conduct for ULD Operations and Handling

Given that it is essential for sale and efficient sirting and air carge operations that all ULB handling and operations are performed to an accountable manner.

By signing to the ULB CARE ULB CODE of CONDUCT:
